EARLY HEAD START HOME BASE PROGRAM



- Weekly home visits with face to face interaction between the parent/family and your advocate
- Parent/child activity planned weekly
- Learn how to utilize the home as a learning environment
- Education about pregnancy and child development and milestones
- Hearing and vision health screenings for children
- Connect families to needed community resources
- Socializations to encourage networking



Home visits take place in your family's home and offer social support and discussion about topics that are important to you and your family. Early Head Start also offers parenting support to teen mothers while they adapt and learn to juggle school, nurture their unborn baby or infant, and adjust to life as new mom.

- Daycare option available to qualified applicants with a pay-for-service fee option or ICCP
- Family-style nutritious meals provided

Center Base Head Start offers services to children three to five years' old who attend class four days per week. We support children and their families through connections to resources within local communities to ensure the basic needs of families are being met.
